1. 2014 Show dates and hours: Thurs., April 10, 2014 - 11:15a.m.-8p.m.; Fri., April 11, 2014 - 10:30a.m.-1:45p.m.

2. Exhibit Installation and Dismantling

Move in: Tues., April 8, 2014

Dismantling of exhibits may begin on Friday April 11, 2014 - 1:45p.m and must be removed no later than 8pm.

3. Booth Rental Fees: Payment in full will accompany this Agreement, at the regular or late registration rates described herein, subject always to space availability.

4. WRPA is not responsible for handling, set-up, removal or operation of Applicant's exhibit.

**5. Cancellation Policy:** The undersigned Applicant understands and agrees that if a written cancellation notice is received at the WRPA office by February 1, 2014 a full refund less a \$100 processing fee will be made. After February 1, 2014 such refund will be made only if the booth space is resold to another exhibitor.

6. Care of Buildings and Equipment: Exhibitors are cautioned that they are directly responsible for any damage to the Building. Nothing may be affixed to any wall, ceiling or floor without express written permission from Seattle Parks & Recreation.

7. The exposition is limited to those persons, firms, and corporations which have contracted and paid for exhibit space in exposition facility. No other persons, firms, or corporations will be permitted to demonstrate products, solicit orders, or distribute advertising matter on the floor of the convention or in the exposition facility. Any person violating this rule will be promptly ejected from the convention hall.

The conference presenters, WASLA & WRPA, the City of Seattle and the official general service contractor shall not be liable for any loss, damage or displacement of any exhibitor's property due to any cause.
